

INVISIBLE COLLECTION

Architect and Interior Designer, Thierry Lemaire's three-dimensional approach has led him to expand his horizon and broaden his palette encompassing a wide variety of residential and commercial projects. Today, from his studio located in the heart of the Parisian Rive Gauche, Lemaire caters to an international clientele; his distinct style mainly focused on interior architecture and furniture design.

Sculptural, oversized pieces defined by the mesmerizing effect of materials: marble's powerful presence, the dazzling gleam of polished brass, the warm feel of wooden wall paneling, the clever use of mirrors to multiply volumes and blur perspectives. The master of glamour pushed to the extreme, Lemaire takes his cue from the 1970's to create luxurious interiors and bespoke designs that are bold & ultra-comfortable. Spectacular, futuristic lines define the spaces where ultra-modernity merges with classicism, and the angular meets the curvaceous.

His tables featuring precious stones tops and polished brass legs; his futuristic armchairs in astrakhan and rich velvets...: An overall style that is often cinematic and recalls a James Bond-like bachelor pad from the 70's. Alongside his many international projects, Thierry Lemaire furnished a few rooms of Palais de l'Elysée, the French presidential palace, including the French President's office.





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
DOCENT







About le 19M

Goossens, Lesage Intérieurs, and Studio MTX: three Maisons d'art represent the Métiers d'art of fashion, decoration, and design at le19M, a space dedicated to savoir-faire created on the initiative of CHANEL. Since the goldsmith Goossens began collaborating with CHANEL in the 1950s, several of the resident fashion Maisons d'art at le19M have moved into the fields of decoration and design. Indeed, Lesage Intérieurs has been designing, inventing, and handcrafting embroidery for furniture and decoration for over thirty years, and Studio MTX, created in 2013 by Atelier Montex, began with architectural embroidery to develop a unique combination of techniques drawing on different fields of the applied arts. The synergy of these Métiers d'art of decoration and design in the same building at le19M offers lovers of "haute facture", decorators, and interior designers among others, the opportunity to experience an unrivalled range of cutting-edge savoir-faire including goldsmithing, furniture embroidery, and architectural embroidery. Grounded in their respective Métier d'art and their own identity, these three Maisons d'art develop creations built on an unrivalled heritage, recognised expertise, and the leading innovations in their fields.





Goossens

In 1953, Robert Goossens met Gabrielle Chanel who encouraged him to create his first decorative objects: a trio of gilded bronze lions supporting a rock crystal globe, followed by a water lily pedestal table and a table with a wheat sheaf base. These are now among Goossens' most iconic creations. By entering the world of decorative arts, Goossens demonstrated his ability to move from the scale of jewellery to that of furniture and art objects, using the same signature materials (gold-plated metal and rock crystals) and the same tools and and techniques.

Opened in September 2020, Galerie Goossens is the first space entirely dedicated to the creations of the eponymous house in the field of decorative arts. Located at 20 rue Cambon in Paris, not far from the house's jewellery boutique, the gallery is both a sales outlet and a showroom for private and professional customers. The Maison Goossens has also called on Philippe Rapin, a specialist in the decorative arts and a collector of Robert Goossens's early works, to help to showcase this heritage. He is involved as an expert on Robert Goossens and as artistic advisor to Goossens.





Lesage Intérieurs

Founded by Jean-François Lesage in 1993, Lesage Intérieurs creates and develops exceptional embroideries for interior design projects. Lesage Intérieurs perpetuates hand embroidery craftsmanship, one of the oldest in the world, relying on both ancestral and innovative techniques. Thanks to its unique savoir-faire, the House accompanies its clients in the conception of their embroidered decorations, whether it is a chair created by an avant-garde designer, textile decorations for a decorator fond of decorative arts, or a replica of the King's bed at the Château de Vaux-le-Vicomte. Heir of a family of three generations of embroiderers historically associated with the greatest names in Haute Couture, Jean-François Lesage, as artistic director, puts the family's expertise at the service of furnishings and interior design. Since he founded Vastrakala, a SA 8000-certified manufactory of excellence located in Chennai, Jean-François Lesage has woven links between France and India and combined the best of the embroidery expertise of these two countries. With a heritage of unique samples and designs, as well as a studio entirely dedicated to creation, Lesage Intérieurs embroiders bespoke projects for its clients all over the world.



LEMARIÉ


Lemarié

Founded in 1880, Lemarié is one of the few remaining feather and fabric flower makers in the world. It produces, among other things, the iconic CHANEL camellias.

Over the years, Lemarié has also developed a unique couture expertise including smocks, pleats, inlays, and highly sophisticated ruffles, made for the greatest names in fashion.

Lemarié has also mastered the art of pleating, following the integration of the famous Ateliers Lognon, which has, since 1853, worked with both flat planes and volumes thanks to its collection of pleating looms.

Feathers, flowers, pleats, couture: this is the range of savoir-faire that Lemarié traditionally puts at the service of fashion houses, and which can be called upon to design decorative elements, window displays, ephemeral architecture, or even to embellish furniture and lighting fixtures.





Studio MTX

Founded in the late 1930s, the Haute Couture embroidery workshop Montex created Studio MTX in 2013 to open up a new field of expression in embroidery: interior design. Since March 2021, its showroom has been located at le19M, a new space for fashion and decoration savoir-faire founded by CHANEL.

Since 2017, under the impetus of its artistic director Mathieu Bassée, the workshop has integrated and brought together all the skills needed to accompany a project from start to finish: creation, materials research, design engineering, 3D modelling, mock-ups and prototyping, production, and installation.

Both a design office and a production workshop, Studio MTX is constantly redefining embroidery and pushing its limits. It imagines, produces, and offers decorators and interior designers new materials, born of the unique combination of techniques that drawn on different fields in the applied arts including embroidery, weaving, tapestry, and leather goods. For Studio MTX, the singularity of a 3D modeler's personality shapes the algorithms of a machine in the same way that the sensitivity of the embroidery artisan permeates work produced using analogue tools (threads, needles, etc.). Its creations thus combine the mechanical production of serial modules—a requirement for architecture—with handmade craftsmanship.
